JESUIT WARRIOR, urged to gain a forward placing along the inside tracking just off the pacesetter, continued in pursuit of that rival to upper stretch but weakened in late stages. LIGHTS ON BRITE settled outside a rival tracking well off the leaders racing to the turn and passed only tiring rivals in late stages. SPECTACULAR ACT was settled in the last flight near the inside racing to the turn and failed to seriously menace. STRATEGIC GAME, urged to gain a forward placing three deep tracking just off the leader, steadily faded between foes racing into the lane. DEXTEROUS tracked the pace between foes off the second flight, came up empty in the drive, was being pulled up nearing the wire, then was vanned off the course after the race.
